The Green Hills Community paid tribute to past and current veterans recently as they saluted a member of their kitchen staff.

Anthony Mickey of Bellefontaine is a specialist with the 1st Battalion, 174th Air Defense Artillery Radar Detachment of the Ohio National Guard. His unit is based in Woodlawn, near Cincinnati, and they have been called to serve a 14-month deployment with Operation New Dawn.

Following training in Ft. Bliss, Texas, he and his company will be sent to Iraq where they will provide short-

range air defense radar coverage and early warning for forward operating bases and strategic locations.

During Veterans Day ceremonies at Green Hills, the children of the Green Hills Day Care Center presented Mr. Mickey with a handmade card thanking him for his service, both at Green Hills and overseas.

Residents and staff shared stories about Mr. Mickey, a talented cook known for his authentic Italian recipes that were served when his family owned Antonio's Restaurant at Indian Lake. A favorite recipe of the staff and residents are his stuffed clams.

Mr. Mickey has been a cook at Green Hills for three years.
